



Infection Control

In 2008, our founder Michael Korn began the KwickScreen journey looking to address the problems of hospital-borne infections such as MRSA. He saw the immediate need for new, adaptable ways to isolate patients and reduce the spread of infections.

Curtains are ubiquitous throughout healthcare environments and have long been the default choice in hospitals. However, curtains are changed infrequently and evidence shows 90% are contaminated with dangerous pathogens within one week.

Patient and staff safety has always been at the core of KwickScreen's values, and today all of our screens act as a physical barrier between people. Superior in its design; engineered with a single touchpoint use, all surfaces are completely smooth and non-porous and can be cleaned easily after every use to help maintain a hygienic environment.

Designed for Infection Control


